RULES AND REGULATIONS SOLO EVENTS 2012  
JUNIOR DIVISION GRADES 6 – 8  
SENIOR DIVISION GRADES 9 – 12**



**WHO IS ELIGIBLE:** Students in grades 6 thru 12 in Collier County, Bonita Springs and Estero.

**CATEGORIES:** Brass, Woodwinds, Piano, Organ, Percussion, Voice and Strings (includes Classical Guitar and Harp). You may only enter one category.

**WHAT DO YOU PERFORM:** You must **play 2 pieces from memory**. They must be of **contrasting styles** from 2 time periods: Baroque (1600-1760), Classical (1750-1830), Romantic (1815-1910), Modern (1900-present). Pieces must be solo literature, no simplifications. One of your two pieces must be accompanied. Accompaniment Exemption: Piano, Organ, Percussion, Harp, Classical Guitar. Failure to follow these guidelines may reduce your overall evaluation.

**TOTAL AUDITION TIME OF THE 2 PIECES: SENIOR DIVISION:** not to exceed 15 minutes;  
**JUNIOR DIVISION:** not to exceed 10 minutes.

**BRING TO COMPETITION :** An original score and an evaluation copy for each piece with **all measures numbered**. Failure to provide an original score will result in disqualification.

**WHAT DO YOU WEAR:** Concert/Recital attire: Girls, at least knee length skirt or dress or trouser outfit. Boys: Shirts with ties, long trousers, suits. Both: appropriate shoes.

**ENTRANCE FEE: \$25.00 Must be mailed to Chairman, Jan Grundeman, 2180 Rusty Fig Ct., Naples, 34120, whether you apply electronically or by mail.** Your check, payable to NAPLES MUSIC CLUB, must be postmarked on or before Thursday, March 1, 2012. Need-based waivers may be requested by contacting Jan Grundeman at 239-353-2216.

**COMPETITION: **NEW 2012, FRIDAY, APRIL 13 (4-8 p.m.) AND SATURDAY, APRIL 14, 2012; GOLDEN GATE HIGH SCHOOL,**** 2925 Magnolia Pond Dr., Naples, 34116. Your audition time will be emailed no later than Friday, March 23, 2012. No observers will be permitted in the competition rooms. No taping or photography allowed.

**AWARDS:** Awards are given at the discretion of the judges, all decisions are final. Winners names will be posted at the end of each category on the day of competition.

**WINNERS' RECITAL:** First Place and selected winners will perform SATURDAY, APRIL 28, 2012, First United Methodist Church, 388 First Ave. S., Naples, 34102 at 2:00 pm. All competitors and teachers will be notified by e-mail by APRIL 19th regarding who is to perform. **Monetary amounts will be announced. All Winners should be present.**

**Established in memory of Daniel E. Turiel (1951-1987)**

**The award for the year 2012 will be \$2,000.00.**
