The Mission of the Naples Music Club is to support music education and performance, to provide scholarships, and to engage in collaborative outreach efforts within Naples and its neighboring communities.

# Program Awards

**The Haegg Award** – The Haegg Scholarship Fund was created in 2009 in memory of Margaret “Peg” Haegg by her husband Henry Haegg and her children. It provides a talented, young student with the opportunity to have private lessons. Peg moved to Naples in 1977 and became active playing the piano with “Forty Fingers,” a group that gave recitals to raise money for the club’s Scholarship Fund.

**Tom and Sandi Moran Award** – Longtime patrons of the arts and founding patrons of Opera Naples, Tom and Sandi Moran have provided funding for the 2010 1st place award in the Vocal Division. Their daughter, Kylene, was a competition winner for several years.

**Naples Opera Society Encouragement Award** – This award is funded by the Naples Opera Society to recognize the talent of a freshman, sophomore, or junior singer and stimulate their continued interest in singing.

**Bert G. Phillips Award** – This annual award is funded by the Classic Chamber Concerts. It honors Bert Phillips, an outstanding cellist who contributed as a teacher and a performer in Naples and throughout the world. He was co-founder of the Classic Chamber Concert series as well as the Luzerne Music Center. The award is made to the 1st place winner in either the junior or senior string competition.

**Clifford L. Saby Award** – Clifford Saby established the Clifford L. Saby Scholarship Fund in 1996 to provide scholarships for Collier County youth. His gifts enabled the Club to augment its scholarship awards and support the purchase of musical instruments in the public schools.

**Turiel Award** – This award was established in 1995 by Mr. & Mrs. Samuel Turiel, in memory of their son, Daniel, clarinetist, composer and conductor. It is presented to a 12th grader based upon competition score, music achievement, scholastic grade point average, an essay, a personal interview, and this recital performance.

**Phyllis S. Warren Piano Award** – This award honors the memory of Phyllis Warren who co-chaired the Scholarship Competition for ten years and was a founding member of the Crescendos piano group. The award is made to the 1st place senior piano winner. It was established by her children, Richard Warren and Priscilla Grannis.

## First Naples Music Club Scholarship Recipient Anita Boqvist Smith

Although the Naples Music Club was founded in 1965, it wasn't until 1970 that the Club was able to offer one \$500 award to a Collier County student for summer study. That recipient was 17-year-old Anita Boqvist. Anita Boqvist is now Anita Boqvist Smith, who began her music teaching career at East Naples Middle School. She then taught at Barron Collier High School and eventually at her alma mater, Naples High School. Her educational credentials include receiving her Masters Degree in Music Education from Florida State University, where she was the featured vocal soloist with the FSU Jazz Band. In 1985, she moved to Boca Raton. There she has conducted choruses and taught vocalists who have excelled in district festivals in Florida and the Southeastern U.S. Her present position is teaching elementary music at Sunrise Park Elementary School in Boca Raton. She is also soprano soloist at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Delray, Florida, is a sought-after accompanist, and continues to sing with big bands and small combos whenever she has the opportunity.

# Naples Music Club History

The Naples Music Club was founded in 1965 by Tom and Grace Truesdale. Monthly musical programs were presented as a public service beginning in 1966, the year the Club originated a 90-minute radio program of classical music broadcast over radio station WNFM.

During the ensuing years, the Club has continued to present a series of musical programs, was an early participant in the Festival of the Arts, led a successful effort to enlarge the string curriculum in the public schools, sponsored "Sing Along Messiah" for many years, has worked to improve the performance skills of Immokalee music students, and has awarded scholarships to Collier County Students.

The Naples Music Club's Scholarship Program began in 1970 with one small grant awarded to a Collier County student, Anita Boqvist, for summer study. Since then, contributions from a generous community have made it possible to support more than 600 of the area's middle and high school students with over \$400,000 in scholarship aid. The Club's focus in 1970 of awarding scholarships to encourage and reward outstanding music students remains the most important part of its mission today, forty years later.

Several small performance groups for adult musicians have evolved within the Club since 1979. Both piano and instrumental groups meet on a regular basis to perform informally for each other or in concert. In 2008, an organized program of scheduled Student Recitals was initiated to enable students of member teachers to gain self-confidence, to practice good performance habits, and to enhance their listening skills.

Over the years, public recognition, by way of special awards, has come from Immokalee High School for providing supplemental music instruction and instruments, the District School Board of Collier County for its continued financial support of the Collier County Choral Program and the Choral Library, and the Collier County Education Foundation, which selected the Naples Music Club as an Outstanding Partner in Education in 1999 for its work supporting music education since 1970.
