



2008 Scholarship Competition Rules and Requirements

Students residing in Collier County that are presently enrolled in Collier County public or private schools or who are home schooled, are eligible to compete in the Naples Music Club Scholarship Competition. The Music Club strongly recommends that students participate in a school or community music program. JUNIOR DIVISION APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS IN GRADES 6-8. SENIOR DIVISION APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS IN GRADES 9-12. VOCAL APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS IN GRADES 9-12. Students will compete in one of the following categories: Piano, Strings, Brass, Woodwinds, Percussion and Voice. **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT.**

1. Contestants must perform two selections. Pieces must be from different time periods, (Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Contemporary) and of contrasting style. Repertoire must be Solo literature, NO piano concerti, NO simplifications. Contestants should consult their school music teacher or private instructor for advice in choosing their pieces.
2. Contestants must have one original score and provide THREE copies of their music for the judges. COPIED MUSIC MUST HAVE TITLE AND COMPOSER CLEARLY MARKED. ALL MEASURES MUST BE NUMBERED AND ALL INDIVIDUAL PIECES STAPLED TOGETHER. Please do not have your name or your teacher's name on the copies. All copies will be disposed of after performance by judges. Do not mail any copies; bring them with you to the competition. **NO COPIES WILL BE MADE AT THE COMPETITION.**
3. At least one piece MUST have piano accompaniment (NO tapes). If you need an accompanist ask your instructor or call if you cannot obtain one, call Marilyn Bogen at 514-0343. The application is INCOMPLETE and subject to disqualification without the accompanist's name and phone number. Contestants must provide their accompanist with music at least two weeks in advance of the competition.
4. Piano and vocal contestants must perform from memory. Though not required, instrumental contestants GAIN CONSIDERABLE POINTS TO THEIR OVERALL SCORE IF THEY MEMORIZE. **(Winners must perform from memory at the scholarship recital.)** **NEW:** A sight reading exercise will be factored into your overall score.
5. The degree of difficulty of your pieces as determined by the judges will be factored into your score.
6. The combined time of your 2 competition pieces must not exceed 7 (seven) minutes for Junior Division and 10 (ten) minutes for Senior Division.
7. All contestants must be properly attired for the competition and the scholarship recital (for girls: knee length or longer dresses or dressy pantsuits; for boys: shirts, ties, and appropriate shoes). **NO DENIM JEANS.**
8. The completed application form must be **POSTMARKED** on or before **Monday, March 24, 2008**. Applicants will be DISQUALIFIED IF THE APPLICATION IS INCOMPLETE OR POSTMARKED AFTER THE STATED DEADLINE. Students who withdraw after the deadline or fail to show for their assigned competition time will be subject to disqualification from the competition for one year.
9. An entrance fee of \$20.00 must accompany each application. Please make checks payable to: **NAPLES MUSIC CLUB**. Enclose check with application. (Entrance fee may be waived if needed. Please contact Marilyn Bogen at 514-0343.)

The Competition will be **SATURDAY, April 19, 2008 at The Golden Gate High School, 2925 Magnolia Pond Circle, Naples.** All applicants will be notified BY MAIL OF THEIR SPECIFIC AUDITION TIME NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, APRIL 4, 2008.

Winners will be notified in writing by April 26, 2008. No phone calls will be made. If you have not received notification by this date, please call 514-0343. Top winners will be REQUIRED to perform from memory in a Scholarship Recital on Sunday, May 4, 2008 at the Golden Gate High School Auditorium starting at 2:00 pm. The announcement and presentation of award amounts will take place at the recital. All contestants should be present at this recital to receive their awards. Failure to perform in the scholarship recital will disqualify the student from competition for one year.

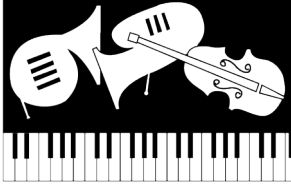

USE OF YOUR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND HOW TO CLAIM IT

Scholarship awards are intended primarily for students to attend summer music camp. These awards usually do not cover the entire cost of sending a student to camp. Some financial support from parents is often necessary.

After the recital, all requests for prize monies will be honored by filling out the "Scholarship Voucher" attached to the awards letter. **The treasurer of the Naples Music Club will make the funds payable to the music camp. Checks will then be mailed to the scholarship recipient to be forwarded to the appropriate party.** Scholarship prizes are NOT applicable to cover transportation costs. The balance of funds not used for camp may be issued directly to the instructor for private lessons.

TURIEL MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

FOR 12TH GRADE ONLY

Established in memory of Daniel E. Turiel (1951-1987)

The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage recipients in the serious study of music. The Award Committee will favor candidates who intend to pursue a career in music or who might consider a serious music avocation.

Although attendance at summer music camp is a top priority for use of these funds, the Turiel Award Committee will consider other options such as private study, college tuition, purchase of an instrument, or other appropriate use.

Candidates for the Award will be selected from the **top winners** of the Naples Music Club Scholarship competition by the Turiel Award Committee. Eligible candidates will be sent a Turiel Award application by April 26, 2008. Award selection will be based upon the scholarship audition, scholarship recital, personal interview, essay, general scholastic achievements and honors, awards and achievements in music. Candidates will perform during the first half of the recital, with final determination reached at Intermission by the Turiel Committee.

The Award(s) for the year 2008 will be up to \$2,000.00.

The winner(s) will be announced at the Scholarship Recital on May 4, 2008, 2:00 p.m., in the Auditorium of the Golden Gate High School, 2925 Magnolia Pond Circle, Naples, FL.
