HAEGG AWARD
RULES AND REGULATIONS – 2010**

Established in memory of Margaret "Peg" Haegg (1915-2008) by her husband, Henry Haegg and her children Larry, David, and Jamey Halpin, Cathy Munsell and Molly Eovino

The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage students ages 11-14 (as of 9/1/09) to study music by providing the winner with a private teacher for a period of one year. Students residing in Collier County and the adjacent communities of Bonita Springs and Estero and are presently enrolled in public or private schools, who are home schooled, AND WHO HAVE NOT STUDIED MUSIC WITH A PRIVATE TEACHER may compete in the Haegg Award Competition. The Haegg Award has a strong needs based component.

AWARD REQUIREMENTS:

1. This Award will require a letter of recommendation from the school music teacher explaining the need and aptitude of the applicant.
2. The student will write a short essay concerning "How much music means in your life, the importance of the opportunity of music study and how you plan to use award."
3. Contestants must perform a short, unaccompanied selection, no more than 5 minutes in length. Contestants should consult their school music teacher for advice in choosing their piece.
4. Contestants must provide **one original score and one evaluation copy** of their music for the judges. Please do not have your name on the music. The evaluation copy will be destroyed after performance by the Naples Music Club. Do not mail any music; bring it with you to the competition. No copies will be made at the competition.
5. All contestants must be properly attired for the competition and the scholarship recital (for girls: knee length or longer dresses or dressy pantsuits; for boys: shirts, ties, and appropriate shoes). **NO DENIM JEANS.**
6. The completed application form, the music teacher's recommendation and the student's essay must be postmarked on or before Monday, March 8, 2010. Applicants will be disqualified if the application is incomplete or postmarked after the stated deadline.
7. There will be no registration fee for this award competition.

 - a. The Competition will be held Saturday, April, 17, 2010, at Golden Gate High School 2925 Magnolia Pond Dr., Naples, 34116.
 - b. **All applicants will be notified by EMAIL of their specific audition time** no later than Friday, March 20, 2010. Please call 239-353-2216 if you do not receive the notification.
 - c. **The winner will be notified in writing** by April 24, 2010. No phone calls will be made.
 - d. The decision of the judges is final.

The announcement and presentation of award amounts will take place at the 40th Anniversary Scholarship Winners' Recital to be held on Sunday, May 2, 2010, at FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, 388 First Ave. South, Naples, 34102 beginning at 2:00 PM.
