



NAPLES MUSIC CLUB 40th ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS - 2010

Students residing in Collier County and the adjacent communities of Bonita Springs and Estero, and are presently enrolled in public or private schools or who are home schooled, are eligible to compete in the Naples Music Club Scholarship Competition. **JUNIOR DIVISION APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS AGES 11-13 AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. SENIOR DIVISION APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS AGES 14-18 AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2009. VOCAL APPLICANTS INCLUDE STUDENTS AGES 14-18 AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2009.** Students will compete in the following categories: **Brass, woodwinds, piano, percussion, strings and voice. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT.**

Contestants must perform two selections. Pieces must be from two time periods (Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Contemporary) and of contrasting styles. Repertoire must be Solo literature, NO piano concerti, NO simplification. The degree of difficulty of your pieces, as determined by the judges, will be factored into your score. Contestants should consult their school music teacher or private instructor for advice in choosing their pieces. The combined time of your two competition pieces must not exceed 10 (ten) minutes for Junior Division and 15 (fifteen) minutes for Senior Division.

Each contestant must provide **ONE ORIGINAL AND ONE EVALUATION COPY** of their music. The music will be presented at sign-in. **YOU MUST HAVE THE ORIGINAL SCORES FOR THE JUDGES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION. THE EVALUATION COPY WILL BE DESTROYED BY THE NAPLES MUSIC CLUB AFTER YOUR PERFORMANCE. AT THE TIME OF PERFORMANCE, IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE ORIGINAL MUSIC, YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.** Your teacher must sign on the application that you are aware of this requirement. ALL MEASURES MUST BE NUMBERED ON THE EVALUATION COPY. Do not mail any music; bring it with you to the competition. **NO COPIES WILL BE MADE AT THE COMPETITION. ALL STUDENTS WILL PERFORM FROM MEMORY!**

With the exception of piano and percussion, at least one piece **MUST** have piano accompaniment (no tapes). If you need to find an accompanist, ask your instructor or call Judy Halpin at 963-1260 if you cannot obtain one.

All contestants must be properly attired for the competition and the scholarship recital. Girls: knee length or longer dresses or dressy pantsuits. Boys: shirts, ties, and appropriate shoes. **NO DENIM JEANS.**

The completed application form must be **POSTMARKED** on or before **Monday, March 8, 2010.** Applicants will be **DISQUALIFIED IF THE APPLICATION IS INCOMPLETE OR POSTMARKED AFTER THE STATED DEADLINE.**

An entrance fee of \$20.00 must accompany each application. Please make checks payable to: **NAPLES MUSIC CLUB.** Enclose check with application. (Entrance fee may be waived by indicating need. Please contact Jan Grundeman at 353-2216).

The Competition will be **SATURDAY, April 17, 2010, at Golden Gate High School, 2925 Magnolia Pond Dr., Naples, 34116.** All applicants will be notified **BY EMAIL OF THEIR SPECIFIC AUDITION TIME NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MARCH 20, 2010.** If you have not received notification by this date, please call 353-2216.

NEW! Awards will be given at the discretion of the judges in each of the categories. ALL WINNERS' NAMES will be posted at the end of each division on the day of the competition. The decisions of the judges are final. Monetary amounts will be announced at the Winners' Recital on May 2, 2010.

All Winners, non-winners and their teachers will be notified by email by April 24, 2010. No phone calls will be made. If you have not received notification by this date, please call 353-2216. First Place and other selected winners, notified by April 24, will perform in the 40th Anniversary Scholarship Winners' Recital on Sunday, May 2, 2010, at the First United Methodist Church, 388 First Ave. South, Naples, 34102, starting at 2:00 pm. **ALL WINNERS** should be present at this recital to receive their awards.

The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage recipients in the serious study of music. The Award Committee will favor candidates who intend to pursue a career in music or who might consider a serious music avocation.

Although attendance at summer music camp is a top priority for use of these funds, the Turiel Award Committee will consider other options such as private study, college tuition, purchase of an instrument, or other appropriate use.

Candidates for the Award will be selected from the **TOP SENIORS** of the Naples Music Club Scholarship Competition by the Turiel Award Committee. Eligible candidates will be sent a Turiel Award application by April 24, 2010. Award selection will be based upon the scholarship audition April 17, 2010, the May 2nd Winners' Recital, personal interview, essay, general scholastic achievements and honors, awards and achievements in music.

The Award for the year 2010 will be up to \$2,000.00.
