Cyrus Forough

Laureate of the Tchaikovsky International Violin Competition, **Cyrus Forough** has performed in recitals and with orchestras on four continents. Forough has studied with legendary artists David Oistrakh, Josef Gingold, and at age 9 with Arthur Grumiaux. His students are prize-winners of national and international competitions and members of professional orchestras worldwide. Mr. Forough is a professor at Carnegie Mellon University, the Music Institute of Chicago Academy for gifted students, and has been a visiting professor at the Eastman School of Music since 2009.

Sung-Im Kim started playing the piano at the age of 7. By the age of 15, she had her debut as a soloist with the Seoul National Philharmonic Orchestra. She went on to win the Eum Ak Chun Chu and Jung-Ang competitions, among the most prestigious in Korea. In 2007 she obtained a master's degree at Carnegie Mellon University under Enrique Graf. Ms. Kim is a studio pianist with Cyrus Forough at Carnegie Mellon and also a piano instructor at the Preparatory School.
